

COLLEGE AWARDS

1. Academic proficiency award

Academic excellence has been identified with achieving high grades and superior performance. This award is presented to a graduating class in recognition of his/her Academic proficiency during his/her entire study in the college. This award is sponsored by the family members of Dr. C. Chemtingla in remembrance of her late brother C. Müwali Sangtam.

2. Rev. Litsase award for Leadership

The outstanding achievement in leadership award recognizes a student that is in one or more activities on campus extends his or her involvement beyond the campus and in the community. This award is presented in recognition of his/her noteworthy leadership ability during his/her entire period of study. This award is sponsored by the family members of Rev. Litsase.

Rev. Litsase Sangtam, a graduate of the Impur Bible School became the first local Field Supervisor for Sangtam Association.

On 21st January 1959, Yangli was officially dedicated and established for mission works under his leadership. He pioneered the establishment of mission centre at Yangli. Rev. Litsase exemplified good character, morals and Christian principles and had the decency to do the right thing even when it was difficult.

3. Rev. Chotsimong award for Preaching

The award is presented to an outstanding preacher in recognition of his/her performance in preaching the Christian gospel. This award is sponsored by the family members of Rev. Chotsimong.

Rev. Chotsimong started his ministry at United Sangtam Baptist Lithroti Ashimükhong from 1962 as an Evangelist. From 1979-1997, he was the Executive Secretary of USBLA. He was an outstanding preacher among the Sangtams who had distinct traits and applied

methods that caused people to want to lean and listen to everything he had to say. As a preacher he possessed qualities of veracity, clarity, authority and authenticity in his preaching.

4. Lanuyanger award for Bible Knowledge

This award is presented in recognition of his/her performance in scripture knowledge during his/her entire study period of the college. This award is sponsored by the family members of Late Lanuyanger.


Late Lanuyanger was born on 15th May 1946 at Chimonger Village. He obtained B.Th from Eastern Theological College, BD from Union Biblical Seminary and M.Th from South Asia Institute of Advanced Christian Studies, Bangalore. He was the Field Director of United Sangtam Baptist Lithroti Ashimükhong from 1972-1975 and translated the Holy Bible into Sangtam language from 1983-1992 and later appointed as Associate Executive Secretary from 1995 till his untimely demise on 2nd May 1997. He was an intellectual person who engaged in critical thinking, research and reflection society and gained authority as a public figure.

5. Sekyüling award for Mission & Evangelism


This award is presented in recognition of his/her contribution in Christian mission and evangelism during his/her entire course of study. This award is sponsored by the family members of late Sekyüling.

Mr. Sekyüling was the first among the Sangtams to be converted to Christianity. He was baptized by J.B Baily at Impur on 1912. Christianity took its inception in the Sangtam area through Sekyüling, a native of Tsarü village on 14th June, 1918. He established the first church in the area in his own village. His efforts were not without fruits.
